

# **Planetary positions**

The Sun is in Pisces.
The Moon is in Aquarius
Mercury is in Aries and retrograde
Venus is in Aquarius
Mars is in Aries
Jupiter is in Gemini
Saturn is in Pisces
Uranus is in Virgo and retrograde
Neptune is in Scorpio and retrograde
Pluto is in Virgo and retrograde
The Ascendant is in Aries
The Midheaven is in Capricorn

Mercury and mars are in the first house of self.
Jupiter is in the third house of siblings.
Pluto and uranus are in the sixth house of health.
Neptune is in the eighth house of law.
The moon and venus are in the eleventh house of friendship.
The sun and saturn are in the twelfth house of introspection.

The most significant aspects between planets are:

A conjunction between the moon and venus. A square between the sun and jupiter. A square between mercury and the midheaven. Oppositions from saturn to uranus and pluto.

## An Introduction to Astrology

For centuries, astrology has taught that the character of a person is revealed by the position of the planets at the time of birth. The astrologer's role is to pinpoint these positions and to analyse the results, producing a coherent whole. Generally, this requires the calculation and analysis of over four hundred items of information, notably:

#### The sun position

Popular astrology limits analysis to the main twelve zodiac or sun signs. Some people are recognisably a member of a particular grouping but most people are more complex. Since the sun sign accounts for only part of the character, it is not surprising that in some cases, the general personality is quite different to what might be expected by a simple reading of a newspaper astrology article.

### The moon position

While the sun position shows the outward behavioural trends, the moon position demonstrates the instinctive and emotional aspects. Where the sun and moon are in harmony, a person may be very strongly associated with a particular sign, or else have the qualities of one to counter the weaknesses of another. Where they are in conflict, the result may be confusion, both for the person involved and for those who have to live or work with them.

#### Inter-planetary aspects

Planets do not exist in isolation. The moon may be situated in a very favourable sign but if it is afflicted by other planets, those benefits may be lost. The balance of aspects will also show how far the person approximates to their main sun sign. A supposedly easy going libran with negative aspects betraying conflict may be quite right wing.

#### The Ascendant

This is the part of the horoscope which needs the time of birth. From the Ascendant line are drawn the boundaries of the houses that relate to areas such as home, marriage, work, health. Without a time, there is no way of knowing how the character will relate to a particular situation. Uranus in the second house, for example, indicates a gambler. The same planet in the seventh indicates someone who will prefer to experiment with several relationships rather than settle into marriage. Whilst a horoscope can be drawn without a time of birth, it will of necessity be incomplete and issues cannot be analysed fully. The extent to which the loss of this information will affect the finished result will vary.

Other areas to be considered are the positions of the remaining personal planets, the triplicities and quadruplicities, and the overall balance of the horoscope. Small wonder that casting a horoscope in full takes several hours and a lot of experience, as well as mathematical skill and psycho-analytical prowess.

From the basis of the natal horoscope, it is possible to consider the present and future life of a person or to compare it with that of another. Most often used by couples approaching marriage, it can also be used for parent-child relationships where it can often reveal significant information that will assist communication and development, or in business to see how staff will inter-relate.

What follows here is a summary of the results gained from the analysis of your chart based on information supplied, with recommendations on areas which might need attention.

### **Childhood and Family Life**

As a child, you probably preferred the subjects which involved doing things with your hands to those which required learning information by rote. The chart shows you are a very creative person with natural dexterity. You enjoy learning but are happier when you are left free to work things out for yourself. At school, as later in life, if a subject seemed interesting, you would work at it, but if it did not, you just ignored it. As an adult, this sort of attitude is often seen with people who buy self assembly furniture and get all the pieces out and start putting it together without looking at the instructions, only to often find they have items left over at the end! A relatively short attention span probably meant that you did not do as well at school as you might have done.

Jupiter in three conjunct the imum coeli shows that you had a generally happy family life with supportive parents. As an adult too you will value your family highly and wish to spend time with them.

Looking at the relationship with your son, the signs are extremely positive. There is a deep seated bond between you and you share many similar attitudes and interests. You like spending time together and work well with each other in a team though there is a clear but friendly spirit of competition between you. There is mutual respect and a general sense of understanding one another. It is evident that you are proud of him but there are some signs that your son may feel some pressure to live up to your expectations, not least because he admires you so much. In years to come there are indications that you will feel happy to share your troubles with your son and that he will be able to offer you support.

### Health

Indications of health in a chart come from the location of mars and the inhabitants of the sixth house. In your chart, mars is in the first house showing that you have plenty of energy. You are also competitive and this, together with an aries ascendant, can mean that you are sometimes inclined to show off or attempt things which you would have been advised not to do. Uranus in six shows that whilst you are generally healthy, there is a risk of sudden decline, most likely due to accident. Special care should be exercised when driving as mars in aries is associated with a love of speed.

Mercury is in the first house which means that you are likely to maintain a youthful vitality both in terms of attitude and physical fitness. This is a positive sign for the future and old age.

Areas of weakness suggested by the ascendant are a tendency to headaches and to ailments which result from doing too much. Pisceans traditionally have weak feet and ankles and they are also inclined to put on weight. Your jupiter is afflicted by the sun, uranus, saturn and pluto which suggests an inclination to greed. Virgo on the sixth house gives you an interest in diet but you should be careful that good habits in food and drink are not just a fad and take due care with your nutrition. Mars in one gives you a generally positive attitude toward life which is healthy but there are escapist tendencies which could lead to over indulgence in substances which would be injurious.

### Career

Planets close to the midheaven are meant to indicate the career path someone will choose. In your chart, there are no planets within forty degrees of the mid-heaven so it is only possible to assess attitudes and aptitudes.

You have five planets in mutable houses which, together with mercury in one, shows considerable adaptability. You will always find work and you are not afraid of hard effort. Indeed, to the contrary, you may be inclined to put in too many hours which may put your health or relationships at risk.

Despite an ascendant in aries, you are happier in a role where you have some independence but you are not in charge. You do not particularly enjoy the stress and responsibility of leading a team or meeting targets. Naturally creative, a role which allows you to express yourself will be preferred over one which is routine and repetitive. You may, however, be in need of some self discipline at times to ensure that you do not spend all your time on the parts of a job which you like whilst steadfastly ignoring all the parts you do not. Attention to detail and procedures is something which you may need to work on.

### Money

People with an aries ascendant are impulsive spenders. They see a bargain or something which they like and they buy it without any thought about whether they have the funds. Since they often have quite expensive tastes, this habit can present problems unless they happen to have a good income to match. The square between sun and jupiter in your chart shows that you like status symbols which usually have a reasonably high price tag.

Pisceans are also often rather gentle and even unworldly people. They do not like to worry their heads about things such as pensions or agreements so they ignore them. This can make them highly susceptible to unscrupulous tradesmen and consultants and can lead to problems. After all, unless a person dies young, they will need a pension and failing to make provision will result in poverty. The opposition of saturn and pluto in your chart suggests that there is a tendency to ignore problems and hope for the best with the result shown by the square to jupiter, financial loss. You need to be particularly vigilant in this area.

### **Likes and Dislikes**

Pisceans are dreamers. They enjoy escapism whether it comes from drama, music, books, dressing up, art etc. They often like to travel and enjoy history. They are rarely political activists because they do not wish to spend their time thinking about such miserable subjects as third world poverty or the intricacies of diplomatic relations or economic growth. Having a soft spot for those weaker than themselves, they are inclined to get on well with children and animals and they may be both kind and charitable. They also tend to like collecting things and making lists. They generally prefer being by the sea or near water to cities, many being able swimmers.

Mercury in aries and conjunct the ascendant shows that you enjoy friendly debate. You are rarely short of an opinion and are not afraid of sharing it. Jupiter afflicted suggests you may pretend you know more about things than you do. You also do not like being challenged or proved wrong.

Your home will always be very important to you. You like and need your own space and will be happy to spend money making it comfortable. Although you like the idea of a tidy and spotless home, you can normally think of better things to do than housework or tidying up which may mean that you live in a bit of a muddle unless you live with someone who enjoys such activities.

In all your interests, you will pursue them with great enthusiasm for a period. As soon as you get bored, you will drop them. It is probable that you start more things than you finish and join groups without any deep seated commitment to them. Whilst this can be a negative trait, it also means that you have a great breadth of interests and can feel at home in many different environments.

### Relationships

There is an innate conflict in your chart between the sun in pisces which suggests someone who is rather easy going and gentle, keen to please and slow to anger, and the ascendant in aries which is vehemently independent, quick tempered, passionate and utterly selfish. Pisceans tend to be rather passive and inclined to dependency on others to some degree whilst arians will often go their own way deliberately just to show they are their own people. How you balance these two sides of your personality is the key to the success or failure of your relationships.

Your moon is in aquarius which is an air sign showing a love of communication and also a tendency to view everything as it relates to you. Your reactions are more likely to be based on whether something is good for you or pleases you than on whether it is good for someone else. This moon placement shows a person who has a deep need for reassurance. The self confident persona may only be skin deep. The sun, saturn and chiron in twelve and a conjunction between the sun and saturn also suggest that you may harbour doubts about yourself. Pisceans are notoriously sensitive to slights. Whilst venus and the moon in eleven show that you have many friends and are a popular and sociable person, it is likely that you have very few close friends and that you do not feel comfortable talking about things like feelings. Even in an intimate relationship, you are inclined to want to maintain a certain distance, a place of privacy for yourself and your thoughts.

The descendant is said to show the sort of person to whom you are attracted. Yours is in libra which suggests your ideal woman is likely to be rather classy, certainly more likely to be wearing pearls than nose studs. You want someone who is capable of making a good impression on your friends and family. You do not like vulgarness in women or argumentativeness. Your arien ascendant makes you rather traditional in your views of how the sexes should behave. A good looking woman who can cook, never shouts but always has your slippers ready for when you get home from work, would be perfect. Someone very career minded or a really high earner would cause conflicts as would a person who had no idea of time keeping. You hate to be kept waiting Venus and the moon in the eleventh house show that you value your partner as a friend first and foremost. Indeed, you are most likely to find your personal relationships develop from friendships rather than casual dates. You tend to be an idealist when it comes to women and it is probable that this has resulted in some hurt and disappointment.

With regard to friends, you regard them as a very important part of your life and you are happy to join in activities with them or organise events. A bit impressionable, you may develop sudden enthusiasms simply because a friend has such an interest. As an adult, this is not likely to cause a problem but in childhood, it may have caused you to be led astray.

Personality traits which may cause difficulties include a disinclination to ever admit you are wrong (jupiter square pluto) and a rather selective memory (moon in aquarius). On the positive side, you are hard working, co-operative and affectionate. With the right person you may be quite romantic.

## On This Day

- 1455 Death of the artist Fra Angelico.
- 1496 Birth of Mary Tudor, sister of Henry VIII and grandmother of Lady Jane Grey. Brought up at Eltham and Richmond, she went on to become Queen of France. Amongst her maids in France was a young girl from Kent named Anne Boleyn.
- 1584 Death of Ivan the Terrible, the first ruler of Russia to be called Tsar. He inherited the throne when he was just three years old and reigned for over eighty years.



- 1662 First public bus service began in Paris
- 1745 Death of Sir Robert Walpole, first Prime Minister of Great Britain and occupant of 10 Downing Street
- 1834 Six labourers from Tolpuddle sentenced to transportation for forming a trade union.
